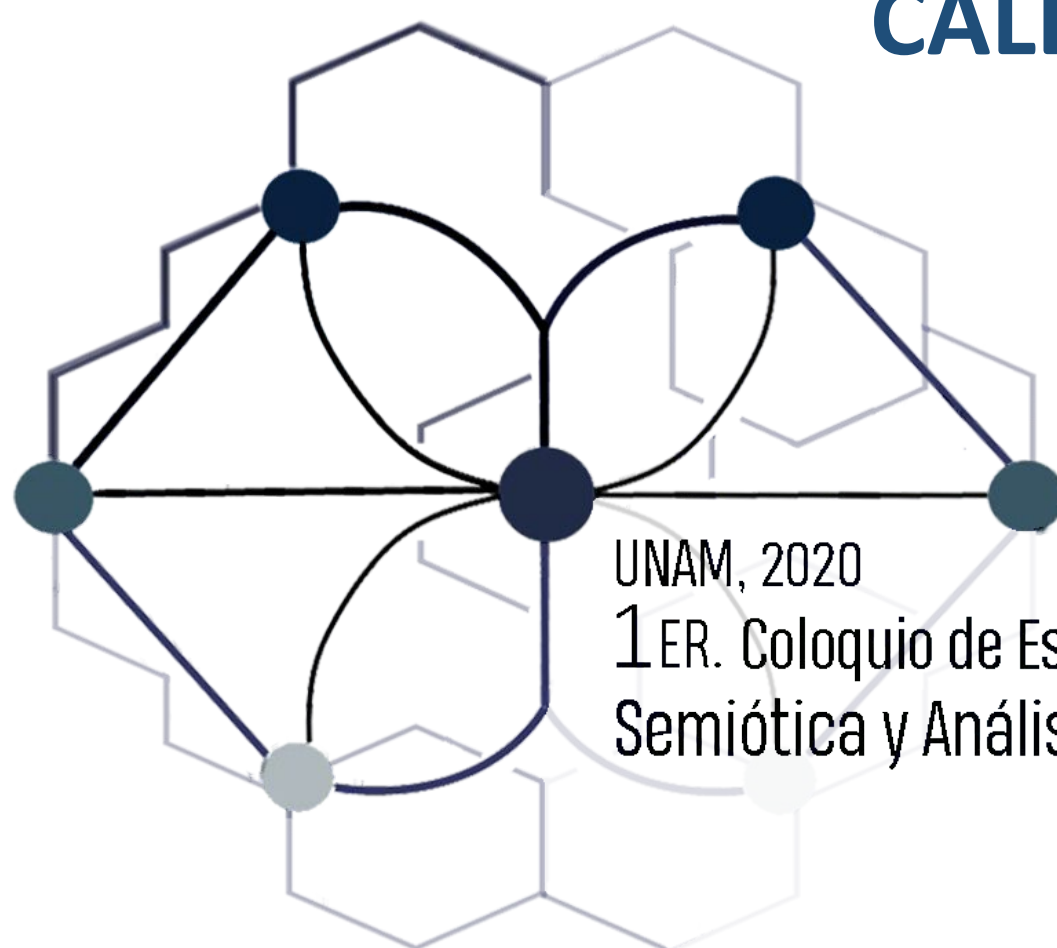

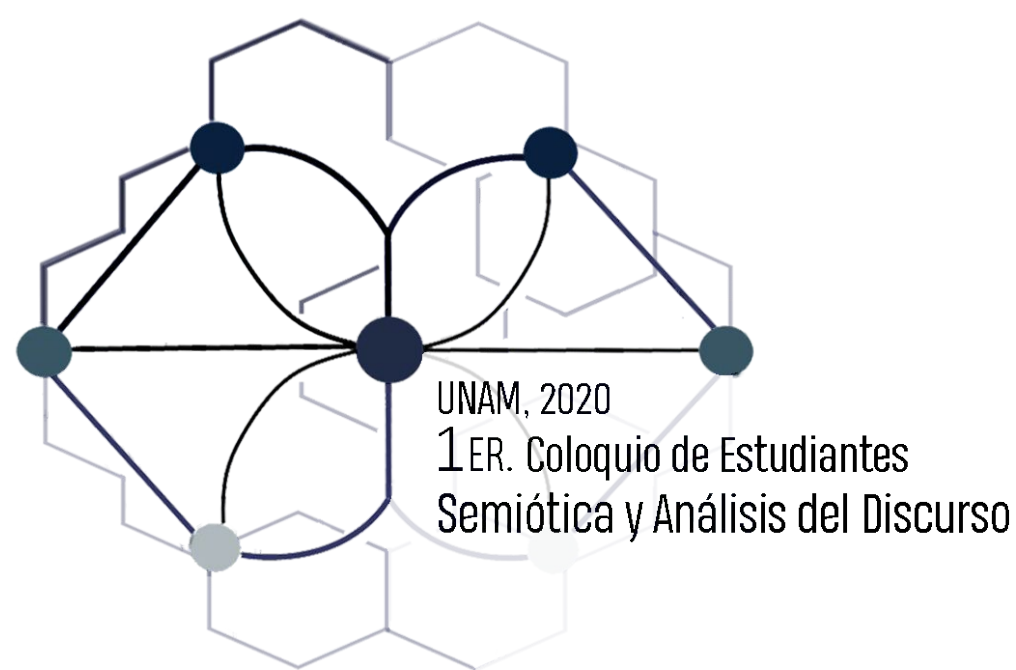

La Facultad de Ciencias Políticas y Sociales (FCPyS, UNAM) and the Instituto de Investigaciones Sociales (IIS, UNAM) through the Teorías del Lenguaje del Centro de Estudios en Ciencias de la Comunicación (CECC, UNAM) summon bachelor's, master's and doctoral students from any university interested in semiotics and speech analysis to take part in the ***Primer Coloquio de Estudiantes en Semiótica y Análisis del Discurso. UNAM, 2020***, which will be realized on May 6, 7 and 8, 2020 in the Pablo Gonzáles Casanova Auditorium, in the Lucio Mendieta and Nunez Room of the FCPyS-UNAM and in the Auditorium and Annex of IIS-UNAM, located in the Mario de la Cueva Circuit within Ciudad Universitaria, Coyoacán, 04510, Mexico City.

The purpose of the colloquium is to know and share research in progress or completed made by students in the area of general semiotics, specialized semiotics, applied semiotics, and discourse analysis. Also, it seeks to know and share the work of researchers in formation to recognize common fields of study that contribute to the consolidation of collective research lines, such as networks and academic groups; as well as generate the interdisciplinary dialogue in the questioning, analysis and resolution of contemporary problems.

The proposals that will be received are those that have been developed within the thematic axes: **theoretical semiotics, applied semiotics and discourse analysis.**

Paper abstract format:

- Word file
- Letter Arial 12
- Exact spacing 20 points
- Borders: 2.5 cm left and right: 2.0 cm up and down
- 250 words
- 5 key words
- 5 sentences curricular summary

The word file should contain:

- Title
- Topic
- Author's name and surname
- Education level
- Institution
- E-mail

Every summary must specify in its content:

- Research question
- Theoretical-methodological foundation
- Corpus definition and application
- Thematic within semiotics or discourse analysis
- Partial or final conclusions
- Harvard Bibliographic System
